

CONDITIONS (Adult)

CONCESSION PASS – NOT-TRANSFERRABLE

- Pass is valid only for the month indicated on regular Calgary Transit services, including Calgary Transit Access and Special Services with payment of applicable premiums.
- Pass holder must be registered with Calgary Transit and must have in their possession and be prepared to present valid identification upon request.
- Misuse of the Low-Income Transit pass may result in loss of eligibility, and may be subject to a fine as defined under the Transit Bylaw 4M81.
- Pass must be shown or given up to an authorized officer of The City of Calgary upon request.
- It is unlawful to reproduce or modify any part of the information shown on this pass.
- This pass is NOT transferable and CANNOT be resold.
- The entire pass must be shown to the operator when boarding the bus and must remain in the possession of the rider on all Calgary Transit vehicles and within fare restricted areas.
- If lost or stolen, a replacement pass will not be issued. Cash refunds are not available.
